

# Jackson Township Recycling News

## Spring Curbside Yard Waste Collection will be on April 10, 2017.

Each street is only checked 1 time. Therefore, it is very important to have your items on the street by 7 a.m. on the date listed above.

Note: Only ONE collection of the Township will be made.

**Branches and green/garden materials can be co-mingled, but must be placed as close as possible to the edge of the pavement and parallel with the street.**

6'-8' long piles are very helpful. Piles can be as high as 4'



**DO NOT place piles on tarps, near signs, mailboxes, poles, cars, intersections, fire hydrants, street lights, or any objects which may interfere with the loading and collection.**

**ACCEPTABLE ITEMS** for collection will be BRANCHES, BRUSH, STICKS, and TWIGS.

- All branches must be cut to 4' in length and less than 6" in diameter
- Any unacceptable items will be left on the property and will be the owner's responsibility
- Any items placed in open barrels or bins will be collected and the receptacles returned to the curb.

**UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS** are as follows:

- Any non-wood items will NOT be collected.
- NO root systems will be accepted for collection.
- NO sod of any kind.
- NO chemically treated products will be collected.
- NO furniture of any type will be collected.
- NO GRASS CLIPPINGS
- NO poisonous plants, stones, dirt or stumps
- NO garbage
- NO items in bags will be accepted.

An agreement with JRM Pallets, 212 E. Mill Ave. allows Jackson Township residents to utilize their yard waste drop off facility, which is open year round, 7 days a week. A yearly permit obtained from JRM Pallets is required to use their facility. Please call 717-926-6892 for more information.

### **TOWNSHIP MAINTENANCE CREWS/EQUIPMENT**

### **FALL LEAF COLLECTION**

**Township Road Crew will begin leaf collection on  
October 17<sup>th</sup> and continue until November 30, 2017  
or first measurable snowfall whichever comes first.**

**NO COLLECTION ON NOVEMBER 7<sup>TH</sup>, 23<sup>TH</sup> & 24<sup>TH</sup>.**

**Streets will be checked one time each week starting at 7 a.m. on Monday.**

**This collection is for LEAVES ONLY. Grass clippings and brush will NOT be collected. Leaf piles containing anything other than leaves will be left at the curb. It will then be the property owner's responsibility to dispose of the leaves.**

**DO NOT place piles near signs, mailboxes, poles, cars, intersections, fire hydrants, street lights, or any objects which may interfere with the loading and collection.**
